**Act of Sederunt (Computer Evidence in the Sheriff Court
Amendment) 1970**

Mada - - - 13th March 1970

Coming into Operation 14th March 1970

The Lords of Council and Session by virtue of the powers conferred upon them by section 34 of the Administration of Justice (Scotland) Act 1933^(a) and section 15(6) of the Law Reform (Miscellaneous Provisions) (Scotland) Act 1968^(b), do hereby enact and declare as follows:—

1. The Act of Sederunt (Computer Evidence in the Sheriff Court) 1969^(c) shall be amended by the deletion of sub-paragraph (c) of paragraph 1 and by the substitution of a new sub-paragraph (c) of paragraph 1 as follows:—

“(c) informing the party to whom it is addressed that he may give a counter-notice in terms of paragraph 3 hereof.”

2. This Act of Sederunt may be cited as the Act of Sederunt (Computer Evidence in the Sheriff Court Amendment) 1970, and shall come into operation on 14th March 1970, and the Lords appoint this Act of Sederunt to be inserted in the Books of Sederunt.
