**The Remuneration of Teachers (Scotland) Amendment Order
1970**

Made - - - 20th March 1970
Coming into Operation 23rd March 1970

Whereas—

(1) under section 2(2) of the Remuneration of Teachers (Scotland) Act 1967^(a) (hereinafter referred to as “the Act”) the Scottish Teachers Salaries Committee (hereinafter referred to as “the Committee”), constituted under section 1 of the Act for the purpose of considering the remuneration of (a) teachers employed whole-time by education authorities in the provision of school education under the Education (Scotland) Acts 1939-1969 and duly qualified for appointment other than temporary appointment in terms of regulations for the time being in force under the said Acts; and (b) teachers employed whole-time by education authorities in the provision of further education under the said Acts, have transmitted to the Secretary of State a recommendation agreed on by them with respect to a matter which the Secretary of State under section 2(1) of the Act directed them to consider with respect to the remuneration of teachers of the said descriptions;

(2) there is in force an order made under section 2(4) of the Act with respect to the remuneration of such teachers, namely, the Remuneration of Teachers (Scotland) Order 1968^(b) as amended (c);

(3) it appears to the Secretary of State that effect can conveniently be given to the recommendation of the Committee by amending by virtue of section 2(5) of the Act the memorandum referred to in the said order namely, the memorandum published by Her Majesty’s Stationery Office under the title “SCOTTISH TEACHERS’ SALARIES MEMORANDUM 1968”;

(4) under section 2(5) of the Act the Secretary of State has prepared a draft order setting out the amendments to the said memorandum which, in his opinion, are requisite for giving effect to the recommendation of the Committee; and

(5) the Secretary of State, as required by section 2(6) of the Act has consulted the Committee with respect to the draft order and the Committee have made no representations with respect thereto;

Now therefore, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 2(6) of the Act, and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following order—

Citation and commencement

1. This order may be cited as the Remuneration of Teachers (Scotland) Amendment Order 1970 and shall come into operation on 23rd March 1970.

Interpretation

2. The Interpretation Act 1889(a) shall apply for the interpretation of this order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

Amendment of memorandum

3. In paragraph 49 of Part VII of the memorandum published by Her Majesty's Stationery Office as aforesaid the words after "1st April 1968" shall be deleted.
