NATIONAL HEALTH SERVICE, ENGLAND AND WALES**The National Health Service (Leeds (St. James's) University Hospital Designation) Order 1970**

The Secretary of State for Social Services, being satisfied that the group of hospitals specified in Schedule 1 to this order and vested in him is to provide for the University of Leeds facilities for undergraduate and post-graduate clinical teaching and after consultation with that University, in exercise of his powers under section 5 of the Health Services and Public Health Act 1968(a) and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf hereby makes the following order :—

1.—(1) This order may be cited as the National Health Service (Leeds (St. James's) University Hospital Designation) Order 1970 and shall come into operation on 1st October 1970.

(2) The Interpretation Act 1889(b) applies to the interpretation of this order as it applies to the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

2. The group of hospitals specified in Schedule 1 to this order (hereinafter in this order referred to as "the group") is hereby designated as a university hospital.

3. Part II of Schedule 3 to the National Health Service Act 1946(c) (constitution of Hospital Management Committees) shall have effect in relation to the Committee appointed to exercise functions with respect to the management and control of the group, as modified and set out in Schedule 2 to this order.

SCHEDULE 2

CONSTITUTION OF LEEDS (ST. JAMES'S)
UNIVERSITY HOSPITAL MANAGEMENT COMMITTEE

The provisions of Part II of Schedule 3 to the National Health Service Act 1946 shall have effect as modified and set out below:—

1. The Hospital Management Committee shall consist of a Chairman, appointed by the Leeds Regional Hospital Board after consultation with the University of Leeds, and 15 other members appointed by the Board;
2. Of the 15 other members 5 shall be nominated by the University of Leeds; 3 of those 5 shall have a medical or dental qualification and 2 of those 3 shall be nominated by the medical and dental teaching staff of the group;
3. Of the 10 members other than the Chairman and those nominated by the University of Leeds 3 shall have a medical or dental qualification and of those 3 one shall be a Medical Officer of Health for a local Authority and one shall be a general medical practitioner.

This Order designates the group of hospitals set out in Schedule 1 as a university hospital, associated with the University of Leeds, and provides for a modified form of Hospital Management Committee (as set out in Schedule 2) to manage and control it.

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
