**The Remuneration of Teachers (Further Education) (Amendment)
Order 1970**

Made - - - 11th May 1970
Coming into Operation 12th May 1970

Whereas:—

(1) in pursuance of section 2(2) of the Remuneration of Teachers Act 1965(a) (hereinafter referred to as “the Act”) the Committee constituted under section 1 of the Act for the purpose of considering the remuneration payable to teachers in establishments for further education (other than farm institutes) maintained by local education authorities (hereinafter referred to as “the Committee”) have transmitted to the Secretary of State for Education and Science (hereinafter referred to as “the Secretary of State”) recommendations agreed on by them with respect to the remuneration of such teachers;

(2) there is in force an order made under section 2 of the Act with respect to the remuneration of such teachers, namely, the Remuneration of Teachers (Further Education) Order 1969(b);

(3) it appears to the Secretary of State that effect can more conveniently be given to the recommendations of the Committee by amending the scales and other provisions set out in the document referred to in the said Order, namely, the document published by Her Majesty’s Stationery Office on 28th November 1969 under the title “SCALES OF SALARIES FOR TEACHERS IN ESTABLISHMENTS FOR FURTHER EDUCATION, ENGLAND AND WALES, 1969” (hereinafter referred to as “the Document”);

(4) in pursuance of section 2(5) of the Act the Secretary of State has prepared a draft Order setting out the amendments of the scales and other provisions contained in the Document which, in his opinion, are requisite for giving effect to the recommendations of the Committee; and

(5) the Secretary of State, as required by section 2(6) of the Act, has consulted the Committee with respect to the draft Order and the Committee have made no representations with respect thereto.

Now therefore the Secretary of State, in pursuance of section 2(6) of the Act, hereby orders as follows—

Citation and Commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Remuneration of Teachers (Further Education) (Amendment) Order 1970 and shall come into operation on 12th May 1970.

Interpretation

2. The Interpretation Act 1889(a) shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

Amendment of Document

3. The scales and other provisions set out in the Document are hereby amended so as to give effect to the provisions of this Order.

Increase of Remuneration

4.—(1) Subject as in paragraph (2) below provided, the remuneration payable to every full-time teacher in an establishment for further education (other than farm institutes) maintained by a local education authority, as determined in accordance with the scales and other provisions set out in the Document, shall with effect from 1st April 1970, be increased by £120 a year.

(2) The said increase of remuneration and any like increase payable to any teacher in a college of education or by virtue of an order made under the Act shall be disregarded for the purpose of determining at what incremental point a teacher shall enter any scale set out in the Document.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Order.)

This Order increases by £120 a year the salaries of full-time teachers in establishments for further education (other than farm institutes) maintained by local education authorities in accordance with the agreement reached in the Committee for the consideration of the remuneration of such teachers.

The Order has retrospective effect by virtue of section 7(3) of the Remuneration of Teachers Act 1965.
