The Air Navigation (Fees) (Fifth Amendment) Regulations 1970

Made - - - 15th May 1970

Coming into Operation 1st June 1970

The Board of Trade with the consent of the Treasury and in exercise of the powers under Article 77 of the Air Navigation Order 1966(a), as amended (b) and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf hereby make the following Regulations.

1. These Regulations shall come into operation on 1st June 1970 and may be cited as the Air Navigation (Fees) (Fifth Amendment) Regulations 1970.

2. The Interpretation Act 1889(c), shall apply for the purpose of the interpretation of these Regulations as it applies for the purpose of the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

3. The Schedule to the Air Navigation (Fees) Regulations 1966(d), as amended in particular by the Air Navigation (Fees) (Second Amendment) Regulations 1967(e), shall be further amended as follows:

In paragraph 7 for "£50 0s. 0d." there shall be substituted "£80 0s. 0d."

 EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Regulations.)

These Regulations amend the Air Navigation (Fees) Regulations 1966, as amended, by providing for an increased fee for the approval of persons who may make reports in connection with the issue, validation and renewal of certificates of airworthiness and who issue certificates of compliance.
