**The Immigration Appeals Act 1969 (Commencement No. 2)
Order 1970***Made* - - - 21st May 1970

In exercise of the power conferred on me by section 24(5) of the Immigration Appeals Act 1969(a), I hereby make the following Order :—

1. This Order may be cited as the Immigration Appeals Act 1969 (Commencement No. 2) Order 1970.

2. The following provisions of the Immigration Appeals Act 1969 shall come into operation on 1st July 1970, that is to say :—

- (a) section 1, together with Schedule 1 (the adjudicators and the Tribunal);
- (b) subsections (1) and (2) of section 2, in so far as they relate to an appeal to an adjudicator under subsection (1)(c) against a refusal of an application for the grant of an entry certificate ;
- (c) subsections (1), (3) and (4) of section 3, in so far as they relate to an appeal to an adjudicator under subsection (1)(b) against the variation of a condition of admission or under subsection (1)(c) against a refusal to revoke or vary such a condition ;
- (d) section 4 (appeal against deportation orders) ;
- (e) section 6 (notice of matters in respect of which there are rights of appeal) ;
- (f) section 7 (review by Tribunal of determination of adjudicator) ;
- (g) section 8 (determination of appeals) ;
- (h) section 9 (special procedure in cases involving national security or forgery of documents) ;
- (i) section 10 (reference of cases for further consideration) ;
- (j) section 11 (rules of procedure) ;
- (k) section 12 (release of appellants pending hearing) together with Schedule 3 ;
- (l) section 15 (financial support for organisations providing advice and assistance for persons with rights of appeal) ;
- (m) Part II (deportation of Commonwealth citizens for breach of conditions of admission) ;

(n) Part III (miscellaneous and supplementary provisions), except sections 20 and 21 (which came into operation on the passing of the Act).

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Order.)

This Order brings into operation on 1st July 1970 the provisions of the Immigration Appeals Act 1969 mentioned in the Order. These include the provisions for appeals to the adjudicators or Tribunal against decisions other than the refusal of admission to the United Kingdom, directions for removal or the imposition of a condition of admission.
