**JUVENILE COURTS AND OFFENDERS****The Juvenile Courts (London) Order 1970**

*Made* - - - 11th June 1970

*Coming into Operation* 1st July 1970

In exercise of the powers conferred upon me by paragraphs 14 and 20 of Schedule 2 to the Children and Young Persons Act 1933(a), as amended by section 17(1) of the Children and Young Persons Act 1963(b) read with section 12(1) of the Administration of Justice Act 1964(c), I hereby make the following Order:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Juvenile Courts (London) Order 1970 and shall come into operation on 1st July 1970.

2. In the Schedule to the Juvenile Courts (London) Order 1965(d), as amended(e) (which assigns divisions to juvenile courts in the metropolitan area and specifies the places of sitting of the courts), for the entry in column 2 relating to the place of sitting of a juvenile court for the South Central division of the metropolitan area there shall be substituted the following entry:—

“4 Kimpton Road,

**EXPLANATORY NOTE**

*(This Note is not part of the Order.)*

This Order amends the Juvenile Courts (London) Order 1965 (which assigned divisions to juvenile courts in the inner London area and the City of London and specified the places of sitting of the courts) by substituting 4 Kimpton Road, Camberwell Green, S.E.5 as the place of sitting for a juvenile court for the South Central division for the place of sitting at present specified in the Order.
