COUNTY COURTS

**The County Courts (Bankruptcy and Companies Winding-up
Jurisdiction) (Amendment) Order 1970**

Made - - - 12th June 1970
Coming into Operation 1st July 1970

The Lord Chancellor, in exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 96 of the Bankruptcy Act 1914(a) and section 218(5) of the Companies Act 1948(b), hereby makes the following Order:—

1.—(1) This Order may be cited as the County Courts (Bankruptcy and Companies Winding-up Jurisdiction) (Amendment) Order 1970 and shall come into operation on 1st July 1970.

(2) The Interpretation Act 1889(c) shall apply to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

2. The County Courts (Bankruptcy and Companies Winding-up Jurisdiction) Order 1966(d), as amended (e), (which excludes certain county courts from having jurisdiction in bankruptcy and the winding-up of companies, and attaches their districts to other courts for these purposes) shall have effect subject to the further amendments set out in the schedule to this Order.

SCHEDULE

1.—(1) In this Schedule, a schedule referred to by number means the schedule so numbered in the County Courts (Bankruptcy and Companies Winding-up Jurisdiction) Order 1966.

(2) For the purpose of this Schedule, an entry in Schedule 1 or 2 shall be treated as relating to the county court named in the first column of that schedule.
