The Board of Trade, in pursuance of the powers conferred upon them by section 44 of the Films Act 1960(a), as amended and extended by the Films Act 1970(b), and with the consent of the Treasury, hereby make the following Regulations:—

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Films (Renters' Licences) (Amendment) Regulations 1970 and shall come into operation on 16th July 1970.
2. The Interpretation Act 1889(c) shall apply to the interpretation of these Regulations as it applies to the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
3. The Films (Renters' Licences) Regulations 1961(d) shall have effect as if in Regulation 2, for "£15 15s. 0d." there were substituted "£25".
