SCHEDULE

THE COMPANIES COMMITTEE (AMENDMENT) RULES 1971

The General Optical Council, after consulting in accordance with section 18(3) of the Opticians Act 1958, do, in exercise of their powers under section 18(2) of the said Act, hereby make the following rules:—

- 1. These rules may be cited as the Companies Committee (Amendment) Rules 1971.
- 2. Rule 6 of the Companies Committee Rules 1959 (scheduled to the General Optical Council (Companies Committee Rules) Order of Council 1959(b)) is hereby revoked and replaced by the following rule:—
 - "6. Appointments to the Committee shall be for a period of one year expiring on the 31st day of December. Provided that where a member appointed under paragraph 4 of these rules ceases to be a member of the Council he shall cease to be a member of the Committee."
 - 3. These rules shall come into effect on 1st January 1972.
