The Local Education Authorities Recoupment (Further Education) (Amendment No. 2) Regulations 1971

Made - - - 8th November 1971

Laid before Parliament 16th November 1971

Coming into Operation 1st January 1972

The Secretary of State for Education and Science, in exercise of her powers under section 7(4) of the Education (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act 1953(a), hereby makes the following regulations:—

Citation, commencement and interpretation

- 1.—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Local Education Authorities Recoupment (Further Education) (Amendment No. 2) Regulations 1971 and shall come into operation on 1st January 1972.
- (2) The Interpretation Act 1889(b) shall apply for the interpretation of these regulations as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

Amendment of 1954 Regulations

- 2. In Regulation 4 of the Local Education Authorities Recoupment (Further Education) Regulations 1954(c) as amended (d) (exceptions to rule for determining area to which a pupil is treated as belonging)—
 - (a) for paragraph (4) there shall be substituted the following paragraph—
 - "(4) Subject to regulation 5, for the purposes of these regulations there shall, in the case of any pupil who changes his place of residence after 31st December 1971, be disregarded any residence in the area of any authority in which he becomes ordinarily resident for the purpose of attending a full-time course of further education.";
 - (b) there shall be inserted at the beginning of sub-paragraph (a) of paragraph (7) the words "subject to sub-paragraph (b)".

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Regulations.)

These regulations provide that, in determining the area to which a person is to be treated as belonging for the purposes of the statutory provisions relating to the recoupment of expenditure incurred by local education authorities on further education, no account shall be taken of any change of residence which is made for the purpose of attending a full-time course of such education.
