The Rate-demands (Amendment) Rules 1971

The Secretary of State for the Environment, after consultation with the local authorities and the associations of local authorities with whom consultation appeared to him to be desirable, in exercise of his powers under section 113 of the General Rate Act 1967^(a) and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following rules.

1. These rules may be cited as the Rate-demands (Amendment) Rules 1971 and shall come into operation on 29th November 1971.

2. The Interpretation Act 1889^(b) shall apply for the interpretation of these rules as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

3. Rule 4 shall apply in relation to the year beginning with 1st April 1972 and subsequent years.

4. In the Rate-demands Rules 1965^(c), as amended ^(d)—

(a) in Parts I, II, III, IV and V of Schedule 1, for—
 “Services for aged, infirm and handicapped persons . . .
 Care of deprived children . . .”

there shall be substituted—

“Social services . . .”

(b) in Parts II and III of Schedule 1, for “the amounts of Government grants and other moneys received” there shall be substituted “the amounts of Government grants and other moneys receivable”.
