The Justices' Allowances (Amendment) Regulations 1971

Made	3rd December 1971
Laid before Parliament	13th December 1971
Coming into Operation	1st January 1972

In exercise of the powers conferred upon me by section 8(6) and (7) of the Justices of the Peace Act 1949(a) as extended by section 4 of the Justices of the Peace Act 1968(b), I hereby make the following Regulations :---

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Justices' Allowances (Amendment) Regulations 1971 and shall come into operation on 1st January 1972.

2. Regulation 5 of the Justices' Allowances Regulations 1971(c) shall be amended by the substitution of the words " $\pounds 2.375$ " and " $\pounds 4.75$ " for the words " $\pounds 2.00$ " and " $\pounds 4.00$ " respectively.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Regulations.)

These Regulations increase the minimum rates of financial loss allowances payable to justices of the peace. The new minimum rates are $\pounds 4.75$, if the time involved exceeds 4 hours in a 24 hour period, and $\pounds 2.375$ in other cases.
