## JUSTICES OF THE PEACE

**The Justices' Allowances (Amendment) Regulations 1971**

*Made* - - - 3rd December 1971  
*Laid before Parliament* 13th December 1971  
*Coming into Operation* 1st January 1972

In exercise of the powers conferred upon me by section 8(6) and (7) of the Justices of the Peace Act 1949(a) as extended by section 4 of the Justices of the Peace Act 1968(b), I hereby make the following Regulations :—

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Justices' Allowances (Amendment) Regulations 1971 and shall come into operation on 1st January 1972.

2. Regulation 5 of the Justices' Allowances Regulations 1971(c) shall be amended by the substitution of the words "£2·375" and "£4·75" for the words "£2·00" and "£4·00" respectively.

## EXPLANATORY NOTE

*(This Note is not part of the Regulations.)*

These Regulations increase the minimum rates of financial loss allowances payable to justices of the peace. The new minimum rates are £4·75, if the time involved exceeds 4 hours in a 24 hour period, and £2·375 in other cases.
