COUNTY COURTS

The County Courts (Bankruptcy and Companies Winding-up Jurisdiction) (Amendment) Order 1971*Made* - - - *3rd December 1971**Coming into Operation* *1st January 1972*

The Lord Chancellor, in exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 96 of the Bankruptcy Act 1914(a) and section 218(5) of the Companies Act 1948(b), hereby makes the following Order:—

1.—(1) This Order may be cited as the County Courts (Bankruptcy and Companies Winding-up Jurisdiction) (Amendment) Order 1971 and shall come into operation on 1st January 1972.

(2) In this Order “the principal Order” means the County Courts (Bankruptcy and Companies Winding-up Jurisdiction) Order 1971(c).

(3) The Interpretation Act 1889(d) shall apply to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

2. After the entry relating to Matlock in Schedule 1 to the principal Order, there shall be inserted the following entry:—

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Order.)

This Order amends the County Courts (Bankruptcy and Companies Winding-up Jurisdiction) Order 1971 by adding the Mayor’s and City of London Court to the list of courts which are excluded from exercising jurisdiction in bankruptcy and the winding-up of companies and attaches its district to the High Court for these purposes.
