**The Justices Allowances (Scotland) Amendment Regulations
1971**

<i>Made</i> - - - -	3rd December 1971
<i>Laid before Parliament</i>	14th December 1971
<i>Coming into Operation</i>	1st January 1972

In exercise of the powers conferred upon me by section 8(6) and (7) of the Justices of the Peace Act 1949(a), as amended by section 31 of the Administration of Justice Act 1964(b), and of all other powers enabling me in that behalf, I hereby make the following regulations:—

1.—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Justices Allowances (Scotland) Amendment Regulations 1971, and shall come into operation on 1st January 1972.

(2) The Interpretation Act 1889(c) shall apply for the interpretation of these regulations as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

2. In Schedule 3 to the Justices Allowances (Scotland) Regulations 1971(d) (which sets out the rate of financial loss allowance payable to justices of the peace) for the expressions “£2.00” and “£4.00”, there shall be substituted the expressions “£2.37½” and “£4.75” respectively.
