The Lands Tribunal Act 1949 (Appointed Day) (Scotland) Order 1971

Made - - - 10th February 1971

At the Court at Buckingham Palace, the 10th day of February 1971 Present.

The Queen's Most Excellent Majesty in Council

Whereas it is provided by section 10(2) of the Lands Tribunal Act 1949(a), that sections 1 to 4 of that Act shall come into force on such day as Her Majesty may by Order in Council appoint, and that different days may be appointed for Scotland and for the remainder of the United Kingdom:

Now, therefore, Her Majesty, in pursuance of section 10(2) of the said Act, is pleased, by and with the advice of Her Privy Council, to order, and it is hereby ordered, as follows:—

1. Sections 1 to 4 of the Lands Tribunal Act 1949 shall come into force in Scotland on 1st March 1971.

2.—(1) This Order may be cited as the Lands Tribunal Act 1949 (Appointed Day) (Scotland) Order 1971.

(2) The Interpretation Act 1889(b) shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
