**REPRESENTATION OF THE PEOPLE****The Rural Borough Council Election Rules 1971**

In exercise of the powers conferred upon me by section 29 of the Representation of the People Act 1949(a) (as extended by paragraphs 1 and 7 of Schedule 7 to the Local Government Act 1958(b)), I hereby make the following Rules for the conduct of an election of rural borough councillors:—

1. These Rules may be cited as the Rural Borough Council Election Rules 1971 and shall come into operation on 14th April 1971.

2. After Rule 10 in Schedule 1 to the Rural Borough Council Election Rules 1970(c) there shall be inserted the following Rule:—

“10A. Any person may, at all reasonable times after the latest time for the delivery of nomination papers and before the day of election, inspect and take copies of and extracts from nomination papers and consents to nomination.”.
