**The Legal Aid (Scotland) (Children) Amendment Regulations
1971**

In exercise of the powers conferred on me by section 15 of the Legal Aid (Scotland) Act 1967^(a), and of all other powers enabling me in that behalf, I hereby make the following regulations :—

1.—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Legal Aid (Scotland) (Children) Amendment Regulations 1971, and shall come into operation on 15th April 1971.

(2) The Interpretation Act 1889^(b) shall apply for the interpretation of these regulations as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

2. In regulation 9(3) of the Legal Aid (Scotland) (Children) Regulations 1971^(c) for the words “Act of Sederunt (Rules of Court Amendment No. 1) 1971”^(d) there shall be substituted the words “Act of Sederunt (Rules of Court Amendment No. 3) 1971”^(e).

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Regulations.)

These Regulations amend the Legal Aid (Scotland) (Children) Regulations 1971 by substituting for the reference to the Act of Sederunt (Rules of Court Amendment No. 1) 1971 a reference to the Act of Sederunt (Rules of Court Amendment No. 3) 1971 (which prescribes procedure for appeals by stated case under section 50 of the Social Work (Scotland) Act 1968 (c. 49).
