**The Herring (North Yorkshire Coast) (Prohibition of Fishing)
Order 1972**

The Minister of Agriculture, Fisheries and Food, and the Secretaries of State respectively concerned with the sea fishing industry in Scotland and Northern Ireland in exercise of the powers conferred on them by sections 5(1) and (2) and 15 of the Sea Fish (Conservation) Act 1967(a) as the latter section is amended by section 22(1) of, and paragraph 38 of Part II of Schedule I to, the Sea Fisheries Act 1968(b) and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, hereby make the following Order:—

Citation and Commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Herring (North Yorkshire Coast) (Prohibition of Fishing) Order 1972 and shall come into operation on 20th August 1972.

Interpretation

2. The Interpretation Act 1889(c) shall apply to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

Prohibition

3. During the period 20th August 1972 to 30th September 1972, both days inclusive, fishing for herring (*Clupea harengus*) within the area of sea specified in the Schedule to this Order is hereby prohibited.

4. In accordance with the provisions of section 5(3) of the Sea Fish (Conservation) Act 1967 it is hereby declared that this Order is not made for the sole purpose of giving effect to such a convention or agreement as is mentioned in section 5(1) of the Act.

Enforcement

5. For the purpose of the enforcement of the provisions of this Order, there are hereby conferred on every British sea-fishery officer the powers of a British sea-fishery officer under sections 8(2) to (4) of the Sea Fisheries Act 1968.

SCHEDULE

The area of sea adjacent to England within the fishery limits of the British Islands which lies between a line drawn in a north east (true) direction from The Heugh Lighthouse and a line drawn in an east (true) direction from The Flamborough Head Lighthouse.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Order.)

This Order which is made under section 5 of the Sea Fish (Conservation) Act 1967, prohibits fishing for herring in an area of sea adjacent to the North Yorkshire coast within the fishery limits of the British Islands for the period 20th August 1972 to 30th September 1972, both dates inclusive.

By virtue of section 5(8) of the Act the Order applies to all fishing boats including foreign vessels.
