EDUCATION, ENGLAND AND WALES

The Provision of Milk and Meals (Amendment) Regulations 1972

Made - - - - - 24th July 1972
Laid before Parliament 3rd August 1972
Coming into Operation 1st September 1972

The Secretary of State for Education and Science and the Secretary of State for Wales, in joint exercise of their powers under section 49 of the Education Act 1944(a) as amended by section 1 of the Education (Milk) Act 1971(b), hereby make the following regulations:—

Citation, commencement and interpretation

1.—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Provision of Milk and Meals (Amendment) Regulations 1972 and these regulations and the Provision of Milk and Meals Regulations 1969 to 1971 may be cited together as the Provision of Milk and Meals Regulations 1969 to 1972.

(2) These regulations shall come into operation on 1st September 1972.

(3) The Interpretation Act 1889(c) shall apply for the interpretation of these regulations as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

Amendment of regulations

2. Schedule 1 to the Provision of Milk and Meals Regulations 1969(d) as amended (e) (determination of financial hardship) shall have effect subject to—

(a) the substitution for the table and the first note in paragraph 1 (net income scale) of the following table and note:—

- (a) £3·40 is to be added at each incremental point in every additional line.
- (b) £0·60 is to be subtracted at each incremental point in every additional column”;
and
- (b) the addition at the end of paragraph 3 (resources to be disregarded) as a new sub-paragraph of—
“(13) Any attendance allowance under section 4 of the National Insurance (Old persons’ and widows’ pensions and attendance allowance) Act 1970(a)”.
