The County Courts (Administration Order Jurisdiction)

Order 1972

Made - - - 26th July 1972

Laid before Parliament 1st August 1972

Coming into Operation 2nd October 1972

At the Court at Buckingham Palace, the 26th day of July 1972

Present,

The Queen's Most Excellent Majesty in Council

Her Majesty, in exercise of the powers conferred on Her by section 20(2) of the Administration of Justice Act 1965(a), is pleased, by and with the advice of Her Privy Council, to order, and it is hereby ordered, as follows:—

1.—(1) This Order may be cited as the County Courts (Administration Order Jurisdiction) Order 1972 and shall come into operation on 2nd October 1972.

(2) The Interpretation Act 1889(b) shall apply to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

2. The County Courts (Administration Order Jurisdiction) Order 1970(c) shall be varied by increasing from £500 to £1,000 the sum which, by virtue of article 2 of that Order, is to be substituted for the sum specified in section 148(1) and (3) of the County Courts Act 1959(d) as amended by section 20(1) of the Administration of Justice Act 1965.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

*(This Note is not part of the Order.)*

This Order increases the jurisdiction of county courts to make administration orders by raising from £500 to £1,000 the limit on the total indebtedness of a debtor in respect of whom an order may be made.
