The Bankruptcy Fees (Amendment No. 2) Order 1972

Made - - - 31st July 1972 Coming into Operation 2nd October 1972

The Lord Chancellor and the Treasury, in exercise of the powers conferred on them by section 133 of the Bankruptcy Act 1914(a) and sections 2 and 3 of the Public Offices Fees Act 1879(b), hereby make, sanction and consent to the following Order:—

- 1.—(1) This Order may be cited as the Bankruptcy Fees (Amendment No. 2) Order 1972 and shall come into operation on 2nd October 1972.
- (2) The Interpretation Act 1889(c) shall apply to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
- 2. The Bankruptcy Fees Order 1970(d), as amended (e), shall have effect subject to the following amendments:—

In Fee No. 22 and Fee No. 39 of Table A in the Schedule to that Order, for the figures "£0 5s. 0d." and "£0.25", and "£0 2s. 0d." and "£0.10" there shall be substituted the figures "£0 10s. 0d." and "£0.50", and "£0 4s. 0d." and "£0.20" respectively.
