## The Supreme Court Fees (Amendment) Order 1972

Made - - - 31st July 1972

Coming into Operation 2nd October 1972

The Lord Chancellor, the Judges of the Supreme Court and the Treasury, in exercise of the powers and authorities vested in them respectively by section 213 of the Supreme Court of Judicature (Consolidation) Act 1925(a), section 365(3) of the Companies Act 1948(b) and sections 2 and 3 of the Public Offices Fees Act 1879(c), do hereby, according as the provisions of the said enactments respectively authorise and require them, make, advise, concur in, sanction and consent to the following Order:—

1.—(1) This Order may be cited as the Supreme Court Fees (Amendment) Order 1972 and shall come into operation on 2nd October 1972.

(2) The Interpretation Act 1889(d) shall apply to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

2. The Supreme Court Fees Order 1970(e), as amended (f), shall be further amended as follows:—

- (1) In Article 3, the words “(1) Subject to the provisions of sub-paragraph (2) of this Article” and paragraph (2) shall be omitted.
- (2) The Note immediately preceding section 1 of the Schedule shall be omitted.
- (3) In the Schedule, column 2A shall be omitted and column 2B shall stand as column 2.

- (4) In the Schedule, in Fee No. 91 for the figures "0.25" and "0.10" in column 2 there shall be substituted the figures "0.50" and "0.20" respectively.
