**The Collision Regulations (Traffic Separation Schemes)
(Amendment) Order 1972**

Made - - - 14th August 1972
Coming into Operation 1st September 1972

To be laid before Parliament

At the Court at Balmoral, the 14th day of August 1972

Present,

The Queen's Most Excellent Majesty in Council

Whereas, by virtue of sections 418 and 738 of the Merchant Shipping Act 1894(a), Her Majesty may by Order in Council, on the joint recommendation of the Secretary of State for Defence (b) and the Secretary of State for Trade and Industry (c), make regulations for the prevention of collisions at sea:

And whereas Her Majesty acting on the joint recommendation of the said Secretaries of State made an Order in Council (d), on the 24th May 1972, giving effect to the regulations relating to traffic separation schemes for ships set out in the Schedule to that Order and coming into operation on the 1st September 1972:

And whereas the said Secretaries of State have recommended Her Majesty to postpone the date on which one of the said traffic separation schemes shall come into operation:

Now, therefore, Her Majesty, in pursuance of the aforesaid powers and all other powers enabling Her in that behalf, is pleased by and with the advice of Her Privy Council to order, and it is hereby, ordered, as follows:—

1.—(1) This Order may be cited as the Collision Regulations (Traffic Separation Schemes) (Amendment) Order 1972 and shall come into operation on 1st September 1972.

(2) The Interpretation Act 1889(e), shall apply to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

2. Notwithstanding the provisions of the Collision Regulations (Traffic Separation Schemes) Order 1972, the traffic separation scheme "Off Kiel Lighthouse" set out in paragraph A8 of Part II of the Regulations relating to Traffic Separation Schemes for Ships set out in the Schedule to that Order shall not have effect until 1st December 1972, and that Order and those Regulations shall until 1st December 1972 have effect as if that paragraph were omitted.
