(Commencement) (Scotland) Order 1972***Made - - - 15th September 1972*

In exercise of the powers conferred on me by section 1(3) of the Chronically Sick and Disabled Persons Act 1970(a) as applied to Scotland by section 29(2) of the said Act of 1970 as amended by section 1(1) of the Chronically Sick and Disabled Persons (Scotland) Act 1972(b), I hereby make the following order:—

1. This order may be cited as the Chronically Sick and Disabled Persons Act 1970 (Commencement) (Scotland) Order 1972.

2. Section 1 of the Chronically Sick and Disabled Persons Act 1970 as applied to Scotland by section 29(2) of the said Act of 1970 as amended by section 1(1) of the Chronically Sick and Disabled Persons (Scotland) Act 1972 shall come into operation in Scotland on 1st October 1972.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Order.)

This Order brings into operation in Scotland the provisions of section 1 of the Chronically Sick and Disabled Persons Act 1970 as applied to Scotland by section 29(2) of the said Act of 1970 as amended by section 1(1) of the Chronically Sick and Disabled Persons (Scotland) Act 1972. The provisions relate to the duty of local authorities to obtain information about the need for, and provide information about the existence of, social welfare services for chronically sick or disabled persons.
