**The Import Duties (Temporary Exemptions)
(No. 13) Order 1972**

Made - - - - - 29th September 1972
*Laid before the House of
 Commons* - - - - - 2nd October 1972
Coming into Operation - - - - - 3rd October 1972

The Lords Commissioners of Her Majesty's Treasury, by virtue of the powers conferred on them by sections 3(6) and 13 of the Import Duties Act 1958(a), and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, on the recommendation of the Secretary of State(b), hereby make the following Order:—

1.—(1) This Order may be cited as the Import Duties (Temporary Exemptions) (No. 13) Order 1972.

(2) The Interpretation Act 1889(c) shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

(3) This Order shall come into operation on 3rd October 1972.

2.—(1) Until the beginning of 1st January 1973 any import duty which is for the time being chargeable on goods of heading 29.44 of the Customs Tariff 1959 shall not be chargeable in respect of Sodium 4-(2-[2-ethyl-5'-(tetrahydro-6-hydroxy-6-hydroxymethyl-3,5-dimethylpyran-2-yl)-3'-methylbitetrahydro-2-furyl-5-yl]-9-hydroxy-2,8-dimethyl-1,6-dioxaspiro[4,5]decan-7-yl)-3-methoxy-2-methylvalerate.

(2) In article 2(2) of the Import Duties (Temporary Exemptions) (No. 8) Order 1972(d) (certain iron or steel strips and sheets exempt from import duty until 3rd October 1972) for the words "3rd October" there shall be substituted the words "1st November".

(3) For the purposes of classification under the Customs Tariff 1959, in so far as that depends on the rate of duty, goods falling within paragraph (1) above shall be treated as chargeable with the same duty as if this Order had not been made.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Order.)

This Order provides that the goods specified in article 2(1) shall be temporarily exempt from import duty until 1st January 1973, and that certain strips and sheets of iron or steel shall continue to be exempt from import duty until 1st November 1972.
