SUGAR

The Sugar (Distribution Payments) (No. 24) Order 1972

Made - - - - 12th October 1972
Laid before Parliament 12th October 1972
Coming into Operation 13th October 1972

The Minister of Agriculture, Fisheries and Food, in exercise of the powers conferred upon him by sections 14(5) and 33(4) of the Sugar Act 1956(a), having effect subject to the provisions of section 3 of, and Part II of Schedule 5 to, the Finance Act 1962(b), section 22 of the Finance Act 1964(c) and section 52 of the Finance Act 1966(d) and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, with the concurrence of the Treasury, and on the advice of the Sugar Board hereby makes the following order:—

1.—(1) This order may be cited as the Sugar (Distribution Payments) (No. 24) Order 1972, and shall come into operation on 13th October 1972.

(2) The Interpretation Act 1889(e) shall apply for the interpretation of this order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

2. Notwithstanding the provisions of article 2 of the Sugar (Distribution Payments) (No. 23) Order 1972(f), the rates of distribution payments payable under and in accordance with the provisions of section 14 of the Sugar Act 1956, having effect as aforesaid, in respect of sugar and invert sugar imported or home produced or used in the manufacture of imported composite sugar products shall on and after 13th October 1972 be those rates specified in the Schedule to this order; and section 10 of the Finance Act 1901(g) (which relates to new or altered customs or excise duties and their effect upon contracts) shall apply accordingly.
