The Consular Fees (Amendment) Order 1972

At the Court at Buckingham Palace, the 7th day of November 1972

The Queen's Most Excellent Majesty in Council

Her Majesty, by virtue and in exercise of the powers conferred upon Her by section 2(1) of the Consular Salaries and Fees Act 1891(a) and section 8(1) of the Fees (Increase) Act 1923(b), or otherwise in Her Majesty vested, is pleased, by and with the advice of Her Privy Council, to order, and it is hereby ordered, as follows:—

- 1. This Order shall come into operation on 1st January 1973 and may be cited as the Consular Fees (Amendment) Order 1972.
- 2. Part II of the table of consular fees in the Schedule annexed to the Consular Fees Order 1971(c) is hereby amended by substituting for fees 12 and 13 the following:—

"12 Issuing a passport of not more than 32 pages ... 5.00
except where fee 13 is to be taken.

12A Issuing a passport of 94 pages 10.00

13 Issuing an additional passport of not more than 32 pages of restricted validity 2.50
except in replacement of a passport lost or temporarily unavailable.
