The Southampton Airport (Designation) (Detention and Sale of Aircraft) Order 1972

The Secretary of State in exercise of his powers under section 14(9) of the Civil Aviation Act 1968(a), and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby orders as follows:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Southampton Airport (Designation) (Detention and Sale of Aircraft) Order 1972 and shall come into operation on 15th March 1972.
2. Southampton Airport is hereby designated for the purposes of section 14 of the Civil Aviation Act 1968.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Order.)

This Order designates Southampton Airport for the purposes of section 14 of the Civil Aviation Act 1968. That section applies to aerodromes so designated and provides for the detention and sale of aircraft for unpaid airport charges.
