#### **EXHIBITION OF FILMS**

## The Films (Exhibitors) (Amendment) Regulations 1972

6th December 1972

Coming into Operation in accordance with Regulation 1

The Secretary of State in exercise of powers conferred by section 44(1) of the Films Act 1960(a), as amended and extended by the Films Act 1970(b) and as further amended by section 8 of the European Communities Act 1972(c), and now vested in him(d), hereby makes the following Regulations:-

- 1. These Regulations may be cited as the Films (Exhibitors) (Amendment) Regulations 1972 and shall come into operation on the date on which the United Kingdom becomes a member of the European Communities.
- 2. The Interpretation Act 1889(e) shall apply to the interpretation of these Regulations as it applies to the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
- 3. The Films (Exhibitors) Regulations 1961(f), as amended(g), shall have effect as if in columns (1), (3) and (8) respectively of Schedule 2 there were inserted after the word "British" the words "or Community".

#### **EXPLANATORY NOTE**

(This Note is not part of the Regulations.)

These Regulations further amend the Films (Exhibitors) Regulations 1961 by including in the form set out in Schedule 2 (the records to be kept by exhibitors) references to Community films. This takes account of amendments made to the Films Acts 1960 to 1970 by section 8 of the European Communities Act 1972.

These Regulations come into operation on the date on which the United Kingdom becomes a member of the European Communities. A notice relating to that date will be published in the London Gazette.
