COUNTY COURTS

The County Court Districts (Miscellaneous) Order 1972

Made - - - 12th December 1972

Coming into Operation 1st January 1973

The Lord Chancellor, in exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 2 of the County Courts Act 1959(a), hereby makes the following Order:—

- 1.—(1) The County Court Districts Order 1970(b), as amended (c), (hereinafter called the principal Order) shall have effect as further amended by this Order
- (2) This Order may be cited as the County Court Districts (Miscellaneous) Order 1972 and shall come into operation on 1st January 1973.
- (3) The Interpretation Act 1889(d) shall apply to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
- 2.—(1) The holding of the Dorking County Court shall be discontinued and the entry relating to that court in Schedule 1 to the principal Order shall be deleted.
- (2) The amendments set out in columns 2 and 3 of Schedule 1 of this Order shall be made in the corresponding columns of Schedule 1 to the principal Order opposite the names of the courts mentioned in column 1.
- (3) The Reigate County Court shall have jurisdiction in proceedings in the Dorking County Court commenced before this Order comes into operation.
- 3. The Pontypridd and Ystradyfodwg County Court shall cease to be held at Ystradyfodwg and shall be held at Pontypridd under the name of the Pontypridd County Court, and accordingly the words "and Ystradyfodwg" shall be deleted in column 1 of Schedule 1 to the principal Order and in column 2 of that Schedule (where they appear in the entries relating to the Aberdare and Bridgend County Courts).
- **4.** The amendments set out in column 2 of Schedule 2 to this Order shall be made in Schedule 1 to the principal Order opposite the names of the courts mentioned in column 1.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This Order closes the Dorking County Court and divides its district among those of neighbouring courts. The Order also closes the Ystradyfodwg court of the Pontypridd and Ystradyfodwg County Court and makes minor amendments to the County Court Districts Order 1970, consequent on local government boundary changes in the Chichester, Newbury and Petersfield County Court Districts.
