## CUSTOMS AND EXCISE

**The Export Rebates (Appointed Date) Order 1972**

<i>Made - - - -</i>	<i>16th February 1972</i>
<i>Laid before the House of Commons - - - -</i>	<i>23rd February 1972</i>
<i>Coming into Operation -</i>	<i>16th March 1972</i>

The Lords Commissioners of Her Majesty's Treasury, in exercise of the power conferred on them by paragraph 8(4) of the Schedule to the Revenue Act 1968(a), and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, hereby make the following Order:—

1. The appointed date for the purposes of paragraphs 8 and 9 of the Schedule to the Revenue Act 1968 shall be 16th March 1972.
2. This Order may be cited as the Export Rebates (Appointed Date) Order 1972, and shall come into operation on 16th March 1972.

## EXPLANATORY NOTE

*(This Note is not part of the Order)*

This Order appoints 16th March 1972 as the date after which the Commissioners of Customs and Excise may pay the export rebate which will become due on goods exported under contracts certified under the Revenue Act 1968, notwithstanding that the conditions governing payment have not yet been fulfilled, if it appears to them to be practicable to determine the amount which will become due.
