EMERGENCY POWERS

The Electricity (Non-Domestic Heating) (Restriction) Amendment Order 1972

Made - - - 22nd February 1972 Coming into Operation 23rd February 1972

The Secretary of State, in exercise of his powers under Regulations 21 and 39(1) of the Emergency Regulations 1972(a) and of all other powers in that behalf enabling him, hereby orders as follows:—

- 1. This Order shall come into operation on 23rd February 1972, and may be cited as the Electricity (Non-Domestic Heating) (Restriction) Amendment Order 1972.
- 2. Nothing in Article 3(1) of the Electricity (Non-Domestic Heating) (Restriction) Order 1972(b) shall apply to the consumption of electricity between midnight and 7.0 a.m.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Order)

This Order amends the Electricity (Non-Domestic Heating) (Restriction) Order 1972—which prohibits (with certain exceptions) the consumption of electricity for space heating in offices, shops, public halls, public houses and catering establishments and premises used for recreation, entertainment or sport—by permitting such consumption between midnight and 7.0 a.m.
