# The Approved Schools and Classifying Centres (Contributions by Local Authorities) Regulations 1972

Made - - - 22nd February 1972 Coming into Operation 1st April 1972

The Secretary of State for Social Services, in exercise of his powers under paragraph 8(2) of Schedule 3 to the Children and Young Persons Act 1969(a) and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following regulations:—

- 1. These Regulations may be cited as the Approved Schools and Classifying Centres (Contributions by Local Authorities) Regulations 1972 and shall come into operation on 1st April 1972.
- 2. The Interpretation Act 1889(b) shall apply to the interpretation of these Regulations as it applies to the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
- 3. The contributions which, under paragraph 8(1) of Schedule 3 to the Children and Young Persons Act 1969 (financial provisions in respect of approved schools and certain classifying centres), are payable by local authorities in respect of children in their care who are accommodated and maintained in the premises of an approved school or in a classifying centre falling within paragraph 4(3)(a) of the said Schedule 3 to the managers of the school or, as the case may be, to the local authority providing the centre, shall be at the rate of £23.10 a week.
- 4. The Approved Schools and Classifying Centres (Contributions by Local Authorities) Regulations 1971(c) are hereby revoked.

### **EXPLANATORY NOTE**

(This Note is not part of the Regulations.)

These Regulations prescribe the rate of contributions payable under paragraph 8 of Schedule 3 to the Children and Young Persons Act 1969 to the managers of an approved school or the local authority providing a remand home designated as a classifying centre in respect of which the Secretary of State has directed that the whole or part of its expenses shall be treated for certain purposes as if they were the expenses of an approved school, by local authorities in respect of children in their care who are accommodated and maintained in the school or classifying centre. They replace the Regulations revoked by regulation 4 and differ from them in that the contribution is raised from £18.55 a week to £23.10 a week.
