EMERGENCY POWERS

The Electricity (Restrictions) (Amendment) Order 1972

Made - - - - - 28th February 1972

Coming into Operation 29th February 1972

The Secretary of State, in exercise of his powers under Regulations 21 and 39(1) of the Emergency Regulations 1972(a) and of all other powers in that behalf enabling him, hereby orders as follows:—

1. This Order shall come into operation on 29th February 1972 and may be cited as the Electricity (Restrictions) (Amendment) Order 1972.

2. Nothing in Article 3(1) of the Electricity (Advertising, Display and Floodlighting) (Restriction) Order 1972(b) or in Article 3(1) of the Electricity (Non-Domestic Heating) (Restriction) Order 1972(c) as amended (d) shall apply to the consumption of electricity by any person in the County of Orkney, the County of Zetland, the islands of the Outer Hebrides or Tiree.

 EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Order.)

This Order amends the Electricity (Advertising, Display and Floodlighting) (Restriction) Order 1972 and the Electricity (Non-Domestic Heating) (Restriction) Order 1972 by removing, in relation to the Orkney and Shetland Islands, the Outer Hebrides and Tiree, the restrictions on the consumption of electricity imposed by those Orders.
