LICENSING (LIQUOR)

The Licensing (Amendment) Rules 1972

Made - - - - 18th January 1972

Coming into Operation 21st February 1972

In exercise of the powers conferred upon me by section 38 of the Licensing Act 1964(a), I hereby make the following Rules:—

1. These Rules may be cited as the Licensing (Amendment) Rules 1972 and shall come into operation on 21st February 1972.

2. For Rule 48 of the Licensing Rules 1910(b), as amended(c), there shall be substituted the following Rule:—

“48. The clerk to the compensation authority shall be—

(a) in the case of a compensation authority for a county borough, the clerk to the licensing justices for that county borough;

(b) in any other case, such person as the authority may appoint.”

3. Rule 53 of the said Rules is hereby revoked.
