The Winter Keep (Scotland) Variation Scheme 1972*Laid before Parliament in draft*

Made	- - -	1st June 1972
Coming into Operation		2nd June 1972

In exercise of the powers conferred on me by section 10 of the Agriculture (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act 1963(a), as read with section 12(3) of the said Act of 1963 and as amended by section 44(1) of the Agriculture Act 1967(b), and of all other powers enabling me in that behalf, and with the approval of the Treasury, I hereby make the following scheme, a draft of which has been laid before Parliament and has been approved by resolution of each House of Parliament:—

Citation and commencement

1. This scheme may be cited as the Winter Keep (Scotland) Variation Scheme 1972 and shall come into operation on 2nd June 1972.

Variation of principal scheme

2. The Winter Keep (Scotland) Scheme 1969(c) shall be varied as follows:—
in Column 2 of Schedule 2 for the figures “£2.10s.”, “£3.10s.” and “£5” there shall be substituted respectively the figures “£3”, “£4” and “£5.50”.

3. Nothing in this scheme shall affect the operation of the Winter Keep (Scotland) Scheme 1969 as regards any winter keep grant which may be payable under that scheme for each year in the period commencing with 1st January 1970 and ending with 31st December 1971 notwithstanding the date of payment thereof.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Scheme.)

This Scheme varies the Winter Keep (Scotland) Scheme 1969 by increasing by 50p per acre the annual rates of winter keep grant payable under that Scheme. The Scheme makes provision for the 1969 Scheme to continue to regulate the level of grant payable in cases where the grant became payable before 31st December 1971.
