# The Marshall Scholarships Order 1972

Her Majesty, by virtue and in exercise of the powers conferred on Her by section 1(1) of the Marshall Scholarships Act 1959(a) or otherwise in Her Majesty vested, is pleased, by and with the advice of Her Privy Council, to order, and it is hereby ordered, as follows:—

- 1. This Order may be cited as the Marshall Scholarships Order 1972 and shall come into operation on 26th July 1972.
- 2. Section 1 of the Marshall Aid Commemoration Act 1953(b) as amended by section 1 of the Marshall Scholarships Act 1959 shall have effect with the substitution for the reference to twenty-four scholarships of a reference to thirty scholarships.

### EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Order.)

This Order, which is made under section 1(1) of the Marshall Scholarships Act 1959, increases to thirty the annual number of scholarships tenable at universities in the United Kingdom by citizens of the United States of America who are graduates of recognised institutions of higher learning in the United States of America, the expenditure incurred in the provision of which is defrayed by grants out of moneys provided by Parliament.
