The Seeds (Fees) Regulations 1973

The Minister of Agriculture, Fisheries and Food and the Secretary of State for Scotland, acting jointly, in exercise of the powers vested in them by section 16(1A) of the Plant Varieties and Seeds Act 1964(a), as amended by section 4(1) of and paragraph 5(1) and (2) of Schedule 4 to the European Communities Act 1972(b) and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, hereby make the following Regulations:—

Citation and commencement

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Seeds (Fees) Regulations 1973 and shall come into operation on 16th July 1973.

Fees

2. There shall be paid in respect of matters arising under regulations made under Part II of the Plant Varieties and Seeds Act 1964, as amended by the European Communities Act 1972, being the matters specified in the first column of the Schedule to these Regulations, the fees specified in the second column of the said Schedule opposite the respective references to such matters.

3. Any such fees in respect of matters arising—

- (a) in England and Wales shall be payable to the Minister of Agriculture, Fisheries and Food;
- (b) in Scotland shall be payable to the Secretary of State.

SCHEDULE

MATTERS ARISING UNDER THE VEGETABLE SEEDS REGULATIONS 1973(a) IN
RELATION TO THE CERTIFICATION OF BASIC SEEDS AND CERTIFIED SEEDS.

Crop entry, that is to say, application for certification when a sample of the seeds to be used for the production of the crop is already in the possession of the certifying authority. In the case of such an application relating to a biennial species, no fee will be payable if the application is withdrawn before 1st November in the year of sowing ..	5.00
Stock entry, that is to say, application for certification when a sample of the seeds to be used for the production of the crop is not in the possession of the certifying authority ..	10.00
Seed levy, that is to say, the certification fee payable at the appropriate rate according to their kind on the final weight of seeds that have undergone the certification process, being seeds of one of the following kinds:—	
Turnip	0.08 per cwt.
Red beet	0.60 per cwt.
Cabbage	0.75 per cwt.
Lettuce	2.00 per cwt.
Brussels sprout	1.50 per cwt.
Tomato	1.00 per lb.
Cauliflower	0.08 per lb.
Labelling	0.05 per label
Drawing of sample for the official examination mentioned in regulation 5(2) of the Vegetable Seeds Regulations 1973	4.75 per sample
