The Seeds (Fees) Regulations 1973

Made - - - 6th June 1973

Laid before Parliament 22nd June 1973

Coming into Operation 16th July 1973

The Minister of Agriculture, Fisheries and Food and the Secretary of State for Scotland, acting jointly, in exercise of the powers vested in them by section 16(1A) of the Plant Varieties and Seeds Act 1964(a), as amended by section 4(1) of and paragraph 5(1) and (2) of Schedule 4 to the European Communities Act 1972(b) and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, hereby make the following Regulations:—

Citation and commencement

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Seeds (Fees) Regulations 1973 and shall come into operation on 16th July 1973.

Fees

- 2. There shall be paid in respect of matters arising under regulations made under Part II of the Plant Varieties and Seeds Act 1964, as amended by the European Communities Act 1972, being the matters specified in the first column of the Schedule to these Regulations, the fees specified in the second column of the said Schedule opposite the respective references to such matters.
 - 3. Any such fees in respect of matters arising—
 - (a) in England and Wales shall be payable to the Minister of Agriculture, Fisheries and Food;
 - (b) in Scotland shall be payable to the Secretary of State.
