The Coroners (Fees and Allowances) (Amendment) (No. 2) **Rules 1973**

In exercise of the powers conferred upon me by section 1(1) of the Coroners Act 1954(a), I hereby make the following Rules:

- 1. These Rules may be cited as the Coroners (Fees and Allowances) (Amendment) (No.2) Rules 1973 and shall come into operation on 7th August 1973.
- 2. The Coroners (Fees and Allowances) (Amendment) Rules 1972(b) are hereby revoked.
- 3. In Rule 7 of the Coroners (Fees and Allowances) Rules 1971(c), as amended(d), for the words "£4.75" there shall be substituted the words "£5.50" and for the words "£2.375" in both places where they occur there shall be substituted the words "£2.75".

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Rules.)

These Rules increase the maximum daily loss allowances which may be paid to a witness attending at an inquest from £4.75 to £5.50 if the time involved exceeds 4 hours or if he necessarily loses more than half a day's remuneration, or if the expense incurred necessarily exceeds £2.75, and from £2.375 to £2.75 in other cases.
