**The Education Authority Bursaries (Scotland) (Amendment)  
Regulations 1973**

*Made* - - - - - 4th July 1973

*Laid before Parliament* 13th July 1973

*Coming into Operation* 3rd August 1973

In exercise of the powers conferred upon me by sections 49(3) and 144(5) of the Education (Scotland) Act 1962(a) and of all other powers enabling me in that behalf, I hereby make the following regulations:—

*Citation, construction and commencement*

1. These regulations, which may be cited as the Education Authority Bursaries (Scotland) (Amendment) Regulations 1973, shall be construed as one with the Education Authority Bursaries (Scotland) Regulations 1969(b) as amended(c) (hereinafter referred to as “the principal regulations”) and shall come into operation on 3rd August 1973.

*Amendment of principal regulations*

2.—(1) Part 1 of Schedule 2 (assessment of estimated expenditure in relation to full-time further education bursaries) to the principal regulations shall be varied as follows:—

- (a) in paragraph 1(6) for the sums of “£5” and “£8” there shall be substituted respectively the sums of “£5·50” and “£8·67”;
- (b) in paragraph 1(7) for the sum of “£5” there shall be substituted the sum of “£5·50”;
- (c) in paragraph 1(8) for the sum of “£2·55” there shall be substituted the sum of “£2·76”;
- (d) in paragraph 3(i) for the sum of “£3·80” there shall be substituted the sum of “£4·13”;
- (e) in paragraph 3(ii) for the sum of “£2·05” there shall be substituted the sum of “£2·15”.

(2) In Part 2 of Schedule 2 (assessment of contribution in relation to full-time further education bursaries) to the principal regulations for paragraph 6(b) there shall be substituted—

“(b) in the assessment of a category B bursary, if the balance of income is not less than £1,500 and not more than £2,000, the contribution shall be £30 with the addition of £1 for every complete £5 by which the balance of income exceeds £1,500; if the balance of income is not less than £2,000 the contribution shall be £130 with the addition of £1 for every complete £10 by which the balance of income exceeds £2,000.”

These Regulations amend the bursary rates and the parental contribution scale which are prescribed by the Education Authority Bursaries (Scotland) Regulations 1969, as amended, to be applied by education authorities in the calculation of bursaries for students who are over eighteen and who are attending full-time further education courses.
