LAND DRAINAGE

**The Yorkshire River Authority (Beverley and Holderness
Internal Drainage District) Order 1973**

Made - - - 18th May 1973

Coming into Operation 13th July 1973

Whereas the Yorkshire River Authority prepared and submitted to the Minister of Agriculture, Fisheries and Food (hereinafter called "the Minister") for confirmation a Scheme (hereinafter called "the Scheme") under section 4(1)(b) of the Land Drainage Act 1930(a) in relation to the Beverley and Holderness Internal Drainage District:

And whereas the Minister has decided to confirm the Scheme, a copy of which is annexed hereto:

Now, therefore, the Minister, in exercise of the powers conferred upon him by sections 4(3) and 14 of the Land Drainage Act 1930, as applied by the Water Resources Act 1963(b), and of every other power enabling him in that behalf, hereby orders as follows:—

1. This Order, which may be cited as the Yorkshire River Authority (Beverley and Holderness Internal Drainage District) Order 1973, shall, unless subject to special parliamentary procedure, come into operation on the date of its confirmation by the Minister.
2. The Interpretation Act 1889(c) shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
3. The Scheme is hereby confirmed.
4. The expenses of the Minister in connection with the making and confirmation of this Order shall be borne by the Yorkshire River Authority and shall be part of the administrative expenses of that Authority.

LAND DRAINAGE ACT 1930

The Yorkshire River Authority Beverley and Holderness Internal Drainage District

The Yorkshire River Authority, in pursuance of section 4(1)(b) of the Land Drainage Act 1930, as applied by the Water Resources Act 1963, have prepared the following Scheme making provision for the amalgamation of two internal drainage districts and the constitution of a new internal drainage board, and for certain matters supplemental to or consequential on the matters aforesaid;

And the River Authority submit the Scheme to the Minister of Agriculture, Fisheries and Food for confirmation under section 4(3) of the Land Drainage Act 1930.

SCHEME

1. In this Scheme unless the context otherwise requires—
 - (a) “the Minister” means the Minister of Agriculture, Fisheries and Food;
 - (b) “the Drainage District” means the Beverley and Holderness Internal Drainage District, constituted by this Scheme;
 - (c) “the Board” means the Beverley and Holderness Internal Drainage Board, constituted by this Scheme;
 - (d) “the River Authority” means the Yorkshire River Authority;
 - (e) “the existing drainage districts” means the Beverley Internal Drainage District as constituted by the Hull and East Yorkshire River Board (Beverley Internal Drainage District) Order 1955(a) and the Holderness Internal Drainage District as constituted under the River Hull Catchment Board (Holderness Internal Drainage District) Order 1947(b); and
 - (f) “the existing drainage boards” means the River Authority acting as the Drainage Boards for the existing drainage districts by virtue of the River Hull Catchment Board (Transfer of Powers of the Beverley and Barmston (Hull End) Drainage Commissioners and the Holderness Drainage Trustees) Order 1941, the River Boards Act 1948(c) and the Water Resources Act 1963.
2. This Scheme shall come into operation on a day to be appointed by the Minister and such day is hereinafter referred to as “the appointed day”.
3. On the appointed day all those lands lying in the existing drainage districts which are shown coloured pink and edged with a red line on the Map (in four parts) sealed by the River Authority in relation to this Scheme shall be constituted one internal drainage district which shall be known as the “Beverley and Holderness Internal Drainage District” and there shall be a drainage board for such district which shall be called the “Beverley and Holderness Internal Drainage Board”.
4. The Board shall consist of ten members who, with the exception of the first members, shall be elected in accordance with the provisions contained in section 33 of, and the Third Schedule to, the Land Drainage Act 1930, as amended by the Land Drainage Act 1961(d).
5. The first members of the Board shall be appointed by the Minister and shall hold office until the expiration of one year from the first day of November next following the day on which they are appointed.

6. The existing drainage boards shall be abolished and any property, rights, powers, duties, obligations and liabilities, which were immediately before the appointed day vested in or to be discharged by the existing drainage boards in relation to the existing drainage districts shall on the appointed day be transferred to and be vested in or be discharged by the Board.

7. All arrears of rates made before the appointed day in respect of any land within the existing drainage districts by the existing drainage boards may be recovered by the Board in the same manner as if they had been rates made by the Board.

8. As respects any matter transferred under this Scheme the Scheme shall operate as conclusive evidence of the transfer without the necessity of any further assignment or deed of transfer.

9. The accounts of the existing drainage boards shall be made up to the appointed day and copies thereof forthwith sent to the Board.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Order.)

This Order, made by the Minister of Agriculture, Fisheries and Food, confirms a Scheme submitted to him by the Yorkshire River Authority for the amalgamation of the Beverley Internal Drainage District with the Holderness Internal Drainage District to constitute an internal drainage district to be known as the Beverley and Holderness Internal Drainage District.

The Scheme also provides for the constitution of a new internal drainage board to be known as the Beverley and Holderness Internal Drainage Board, and for the abolition of the drainage boards for the existing Beverley Internal Drainage District and the existing Holderness Internal Drainage District.

The map mentioned in the Scheme is available for inspection during office hours at the Office of the Minister of Agriculture, Fisheries and Food, Great Westminster House, Horseferry Road, London SW1P 2AE, and a certified copy thereof may be inspected during office hours at the Office of the Beverley and Holderness Internal Drainage Board.
