**Milk and Meals (Education) (Scotland) (Amendment No. 2)  
Regulations 1973**

<i>Made</i>	- - -	18th July 1973
<i>Laid before Parliament</i>		27th July 1973
<i>Coming into Operation</i>		13th August 1973

In exercise of the powers conferred on me by sections 53(3) and 144(5) of the Education (Scotland) Act 1962(a), and of all other powers enabling me in that behalf, I hereby make the following regulations:—

*Citation, commencement and interpretation*

1.—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Milk and Meals (Education) (Scotland) (Amendment No. 2) Regulations 1973 and shall be included among the regulations which may be cited together as the Milk and Meals (Education) (Scotland) Regulations 1971 to 1973.

(2) These regulations shall come into operation on 13th August 1973.

(3) The Interpretation Act 1889(b) shall apply for the interpretation of these regulations as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

*Amendment of principal regulations*

2.—(1) Regulation 7 of the Milk and Meals (Education) (Scotland) Regulations 1971(c) as amended(d) shall have effect subject to—

(a) the substitution for the first paragraph of paragraph (4) of the following paragraph:—

“Arrangements made by an education authority—

(a) under sub-paragraphs (a) and (b) of paragraph (2) of this regulation shall include provision for the remission of any charge mentioned in the sub-paragraphs in the case of any parent who satisfies them that he is unable to pay it without financial hardship; and

(b) under paragraph (3) of this regulation may include provision for the remission of the charge in the case of any parent in whose case the charge under sub-paragraph (b) of paragraph (2) is remitted.”

(b) in the second paragraph of paragraph (4) the insertion after the words

“under the said sub-paragraphs (a) and (b)” of the words “of paragraph (2) or under the said paragraph (3)”.

(2) The Schedule to the Milk and Meals (Education) (Scotland) Regulations 1971 (determination of financial hardship) shall have effect subject to the substitution for the table and the first note of the following table and note.

## EXPLANATORY NOTE

*(This Note is not part of the Regulations.)*

These Regulations enable an education authority to remit the charge for other meals and refreshments provided in day special schools to pupils to whom the authority give the midday meal free of charge and amend the provisions of the Milk and Meals (Education) (Scotland) Regulations 1971 for the calculation of a parent's income for the purpose of determining his entitlement to remission of the charge for schools meals or refreshments.
