- 1. This Order may be cited as the Criminal Justice Act 1972 (Commencement No. 3) Order 1973.
- **2.** The provisions of the Criminal Justice Act 1972 specified in the Schedules to this Order shall come into force on the dates mentioned in the heading of those Schedules.
