The Awards (First Degree, etc. Courses) (Amendment No. 3)
Regulations 1973

Made - - - 28th September 1973
Laid before Parliament 9th October 1973
Coming into Operation 1st November 1973

The Secretary of State for Education and Science, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 1 of the Education Act 1962(a) and vested in her(b), hereby makes the following regulations:—

Citation, commencement and interpretation

1.—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Awards (First Degree, etc. Courses) (Amendment No. 3) Regulations 1973 and shall come into operation on 1st November 1973.

(2) The Interpretation Act 1889(c) shall apply for the interpretation of these regulations as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

Amendment of regulations

2.—(1) For paragraph 2(1)(b) of schedule 3 (women students) to the Awards (First Degree, etc. Courses) Regulations 1971(d) (“the 1971 Regulations”) there shall be substituted—

“(b) her requirements under paragraph 4 shall be £4·90 for each additional week or incomplete part of a week”.

(2) In paragraph 4(1) of the Awards (First Degree, etc. Courses) (Amendment) Regulations 1973(e) the reference to paragraph 8(1)(b) of schedule 1 to the 1971 Regulations shall be read as a reference to paragraph 8 of that schedule.
