**The Export of Goods (Control) (Amendment No. 4) Order
1973**

Made - - - - 25th October 1973

Coming into Operation 26th October 1973

The Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 1 of the Import, Export and Customs Powers (Defence) Act 1939(a) and now vested in him(b), hereby orders as follows:

1.—(1) This Order may be cited as the Export of Goods (Control) (Amendment No. 4) Order 1973 and shall come into operation on 26th October 1973.

(2) The Interpretation Act 1889(c) shall apply to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

2. The Export of Goods (Control) Order 1970(d), as amended(e), shall have effect as if:

(a) at the end of Article 5(1) (certain exceptions to export control) there were added the following:

“ *Transshipment of petroleum oils, etc.*

(m) Petroleum oils and oils obtained from bituminous minerals to any destination if imported into the United Kingdom for transshipment ”;

(b) in Schedule 1, Group 5, there were included the following entry:

“ Petroleum oils and oils obtained from
bituminous minerals A ”

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Order.)

This Order further amends the Export of Goods (Control) Order 1970 by imposing export control on petroleum oils and oils obtained from bituminous minerals to destinations outside the United Kingdom unless they were imported into the United Kingdom for transshipment.
