# The Coroners (Fees and Allowances) (Amendment) (No. 3) Rules 1973

9th November 1973

Coming into Operation

3rd December 1973

In exercise of the powers conferred upon me by section 1(1) of the Coroners Act 1954(a), I hereby make the following Rules:—

- 1. These Rules may be cited as the Coroners (Fees and Allowances) (Amendment) (No. 3) Rules 1973 and shall come into operation on 3rd December 1973.
- 2. Rule 4(3) of the Coroners (Fees and Allowances) Rules 1971 (b), as amended(c), shall be amended by the substitution of the words "6p" for the words "5·6p".
- **3.** Rule 8 of the said Rules shall be amended by the substitution of the words "62p", "£1·35", "£2·40", "£3·40", "£4·05", "£8·65", and "80p" for the words "57p", "£1·25", "£2·20", "£3·12", "£3·75", "£8·00" and "75p" respectively.
- **4.** Rule 9 of the said Rules shall be amended by the substitution of the words "£6.25" and "80p" for the words "£5.80" and "75p" respectively.
  - 5. Rule 10(3) of the said Rules shall be amended as follows:—
    - (a) in sub-paragraph (b) the words "4.4p", "5.5p" and "6.0p" shall be substituted for the words "4.1p", "5.1p" and "5.6p" respectively;
    - (b) in sub-paragraph (c) the words "2.7p" shall be substituted for the words "2.6p".
