Crystal Glass (Descriptions) Regulations 1973

6. A trade mark, the name of an undertaking or any other inscription containing as a main part, as an adjective or as a root one of the descriptions specified in the Schedule hereto or a description likely to be confused therewith, shall not be applied to glass unless the trade mark, name or other inscription is, in very prominent lettering, immediately preceded—

- (a) if the glass is glass to which a description specified in the Schedule hereto may lawfully be applied, by any such description;
- (b) in any other case, by a statement of the exact nature of the glass.
